Missouri's electric cooperatives have a long and proud history of professionalism and service. Our mission is to continue that record in the future.

The legislative staff of the Association of Missouri Electric Cooperatives represents the interests of Missouri's non-profit, member-owned rural electric cooperatives and their members before the General Assembly as well as state and local government. We are here to serve you when you need accurate, reliable and up-to-date information about Missouri's electric cooperatives, or the electric utility industry.

Missouri is served by 40 member-oriented electric distribution cooperatives. Together, these locally owned cooperatives serve nearly 775,000 homes, businesses and farms in rural Missouri. We operate in almost every rural county and often are leaders in community progress and economic development.

Furthermore, Missouri's electric cooperatives have built a network of

transmission cooperatives that provide access to wholesale power that few states enjoy. The third element in Missouri's three-tiered electric cooperative system is Associated Electric Cooperative of Springfield. Our generation cooperative is one of the lowest-cost power providers in America.

Because Missouri's electric cooperatives are grassroots organizations, supervised by people who use the services the co-ops provide, you can be assured that our systems operate with the interest of consumers in mind. Each of our cooperatives is governed by a board of directors elected by the membership.

These member-directors set policies that affect not only their neighbors, but also their own utility service. This model of citizen-consumer governance has continued to ensure the electric cooperatives

provide low cost and reliable electricity service to the state's rural residents for more than three-quarters of a century.

Missouri's electric cooperatives are pillars in the communities they serve. It is the great pleasure of AMEC's legislative staff to represent these fine organizations within the halls of government.

As your work touches on issues relating to electricity, energy production, conservation or efficiency, we hope you will turn to us for reliable and accurate information. We can also be of great assistance in dealing with issues of economic and community development in rural areas.

Electric cooperatives in general and Missouri's electric cooperatives, specifically, have a long and proud history of professionalism and service. Our mission is to continue that record long into the future.

Our Proud History



In the 1930s, rural people lived lifestyles similar to that of their pioneer ancestors. Their children suffered while trying to do homework by the feeble light of lanterns. Without “luxuries” like indoor plumbing and refrigeration, the bright lights of the cities lured away the best and brightest rural youth.

In 1935, the Rural Electrification Administration, or REA, was established. Its purpose was to make low-cost loans available to bring rural America out of the darkness. At first it was believed that private power companies already in existence would use these REA funds to extend their lines into the countryside. This did not happen because the low density of rural areas would not allow the private power companies to make sufficient profit.

Instead, the farmers and other rural people took matters into their own hands and used the cooperative business model to form more than 1,000 rural electric cooperatives. Through determination, dedication, and hard work, electric coopera-

tives have overcome every obstacle placed in their paths. When power supply became an issue they built their own power plants. When transmission did not meet their needs they built their own. When ice storms, tornadoes, hurricanes and floods brought down the lines they worked together to rebuild.

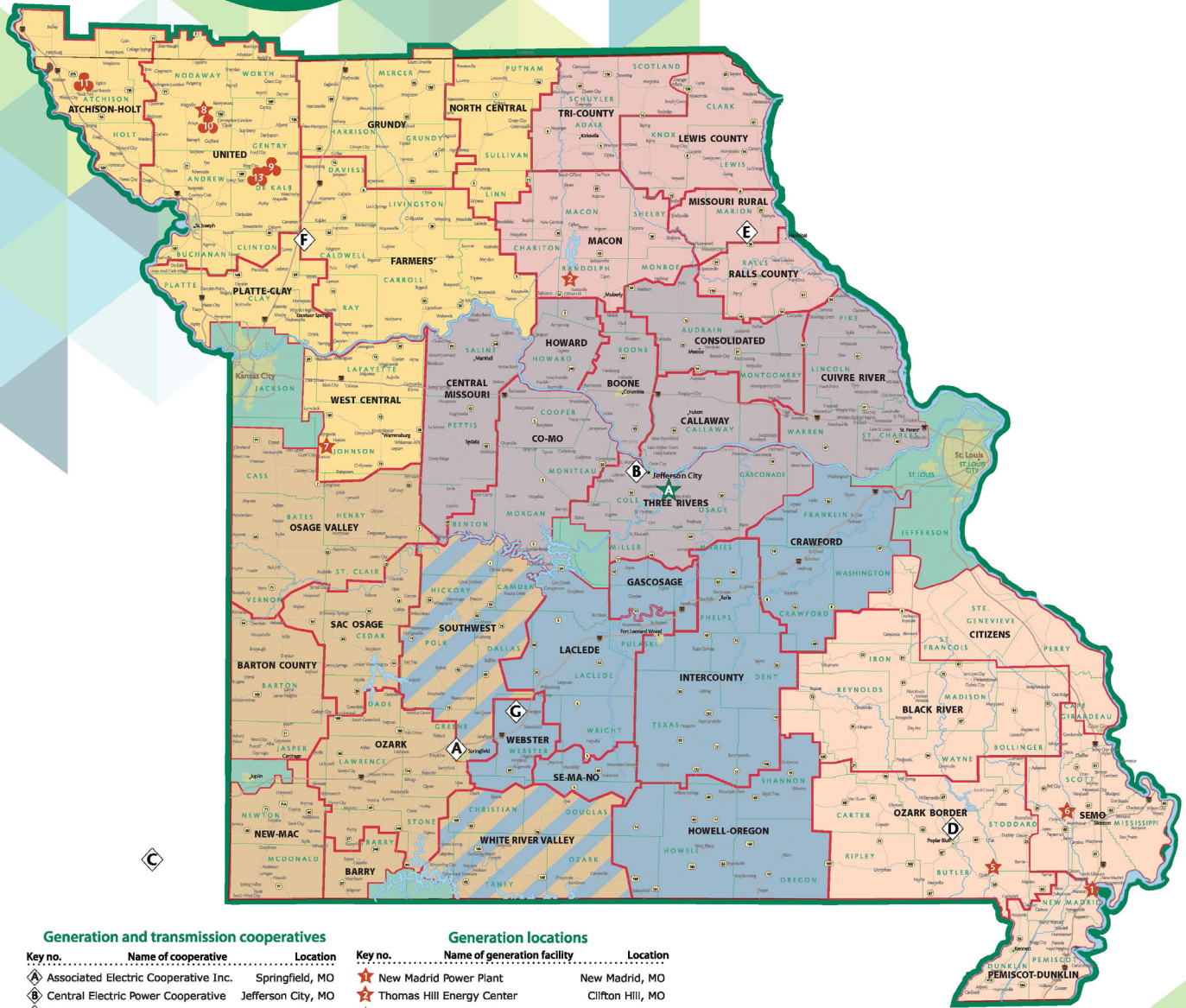
Over the years, electric cooperatives have served as a catalyst for the revitalization of America’s rural communities. They began by making rural businesses possible and continue to work directly to promote rural areas as good places in which to do business. Today electric cooperatives can be found behind nearly every economic development project that has the potential to provide jobs for members; however, they are not content to rest on past successes.

Electric cooperatives continue to raise the standard of living for their members by bringing satellite TV, broadband internet and other services vital to the success of rural communities.

The Cooperative Difference

Our Three Tier System

Missouri's electric cooperative network is organized into three tiers, each with a distinct responsibility.

At the top are 40 local distribution cooperatives that provide electric service directly to consumer-members, including businesses, farms and households.

At the second level of the system are the six regional generation and transmission (or G&T) cooperatives that transmit power from the generators to the distribution systems

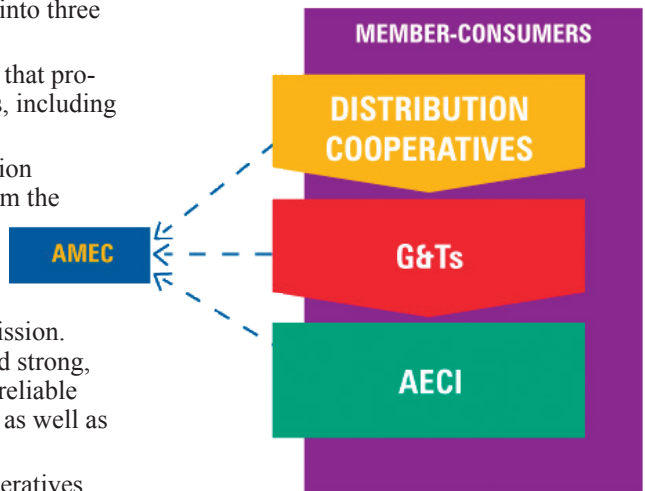
In 1961, the six G&Ts joined together to form Associated Electric Cooperative, Inc., the system's third tier. AECI takes care of generation, power procurement and high-voltage transmission. Over the years, AECI has built a diverse generating portfolio and strong, integrated transmission system which provides economical and reliable power to transmission and distribution cooperatives in Missouri as well as parts of Iowa and Oklahoma.

This three-tiered system is unique to Missouri's electric cooperatives and provides an excellent structure to keep rates low and service reliable.

Tying the three tiers of Missouri's electric cooperative system together is the Association of Missouri Electric Cooperatives (AMEC). AMEC is a statewide organization based in Jefferson City. Since its founding in 1937, AMEC has been the voice of the 40 electric distribution cooperatives and seven generation and transmission systems in the state which provide electric service to almost 775,000 rural homes, farms, industries, and institutions representing more than 2 million Missourians.

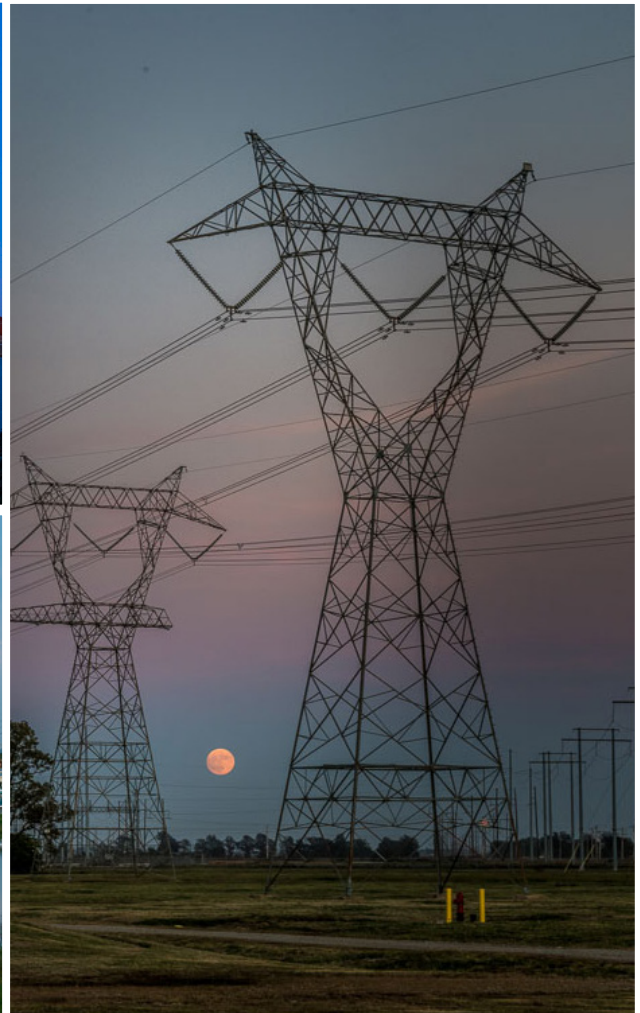
Each department within AMEC—legislative and government relations, member services, internal operations, risk management & training, and communications—works closely with our local cooperative systems. Our mission is to provide a means for electric cooperatives to accomplish things collectively that they could not do as effectively on their own.

Each of the cooperatives in the non-profit rural electric system is owned by the members it serves and operates under the guidance of a board of directors elected by the membership. Likewise, AMEC is non-profit, member-owned and controlled by a board of its member systems. By working together, and focusing on member needs, cooperatives continue sustainable development of rural communities. That's the cooperative way of doing business.

Associated Electric Cooperative provides reliable, affordable electricity to rural electric cooperatives, responsibly generating power while protecting the land, air, and water resources important to members and their quality of life. Associated is a wholesale power cooperative owned by six regional cooperatives, which in turn are owned by 51 local cooperatives in Missouri, southeast Iowa and northeast Oklahoma which serve nearly 935,000 members.

Associated uses a mix of resources and a strong integrated transmission system to provide economical, reliable wholesale power supply to member cooperatives.

Associated's diverse resources, including coal, natural gas, wind, hydropower and energy efficiency programs, produce low-cost power. Associated brought the first utility-scale wind farms to Missouri and now receives power from eight farms. That includes two wind farms added in 2020, bringing Associated's contracted wind energy to more than 1,240 megawatts of electricity. Associated Electric also helps member co-ops inform and assist their members who are interested in residential solar and wind systems, as well as electric vehicles. Associated also contracts for wind energy and renewable hydropower.

Another resource is Associated's Take Control & Save energy efficiency program, which builds on Missouri electric cooperatives' longtime work to help members use electricity more efficiently and save money.

Associated offers its Power4Progress economic development program to member cooperatives who want to help communities grow.

Associated's environmental stewardship has been recognized nationally. It was selected Wind Co-op of the Year in 2006 by the U.S. Department of Energy. It's also received the U.S. Department of Interior's highest award – twice – for its innovative and responsible transformation of once-mined land into a mix of wildlife habitat, pasture and wetlands.

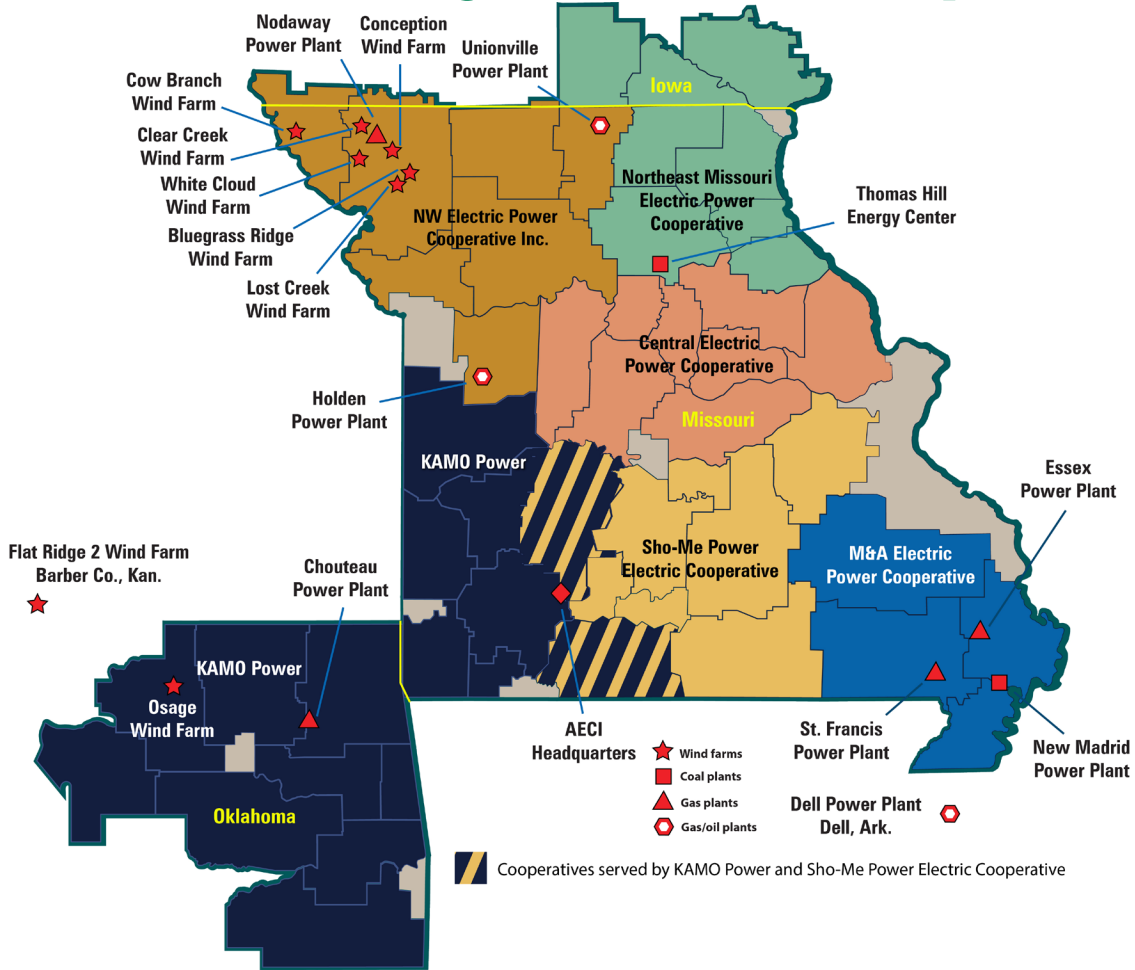
Associated has improved air quality by investing more than \$1.1 billion since 1994 to reduce sulfur dioxide, nitrogen oxides and mercury emissions 80 to 90 percent.

The cooperative is part of the collaborative "Missourians for Monarchs" and has allocated 32 acres and funding for a pollinator plot. It also was recognized in 2018 by the National Association of Conservation Districts for its agricultural research farm project focused on improving soil health.

Associated Electric is among the very few utilities rated AA- by Fitch Ratings Ltd., Aa3 by Moody's Investors Service and AA by Standard & Poor's Financial Services LLC.

The financially strong cooperative employs about 650 skilled employees and is headquartered in Springfield, Mo. Associated is a Touchstone Energy Cooperative. Learn more at www.aeci.org.

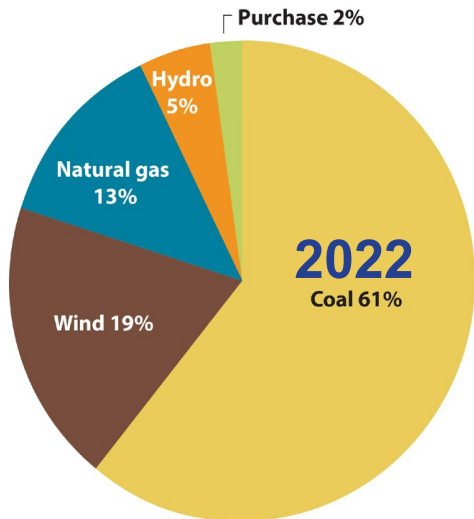
AECI System Map

Generation to serve member load

Associated Electric Cooperative is part of a three-tiered system united by the common purpose of serving electric cooperative members with reliable, affordable and responsible electricity. Associated is owned by six generation and transmission cooperatives (G&Ts) that formed it in 1961 to provide them a wholesale power supply. These six G&Ts are owned by 51 distribution cooperatives in Missouri, southeast Iowa and northeast Oklahoma. The 51 local electric cooperatives serve more than 935,000 meters, representing about two million member-consumers.

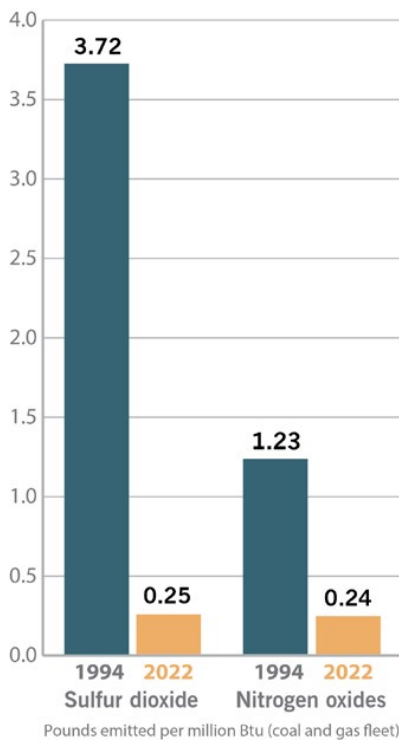


Power supply facts

AECI has history of environmental stewardship

Associated Electric Cooperative and its members have spent more than \$1.1 billion to reduce emissions since 1994, and we're proud of the tremendous improvements in air quality we have achieved. Our focus on serving members drives us to be good stewards of the environment and of our members' resources. Balancing these responsibilities will continue to be important, as well as difficult.

Associated improves air quality



Associated Electric Cooperative has improved air quality with significant investments and innovative research – and kept members' electricity reliable and affordable. Chart shows 1994 emissions from fleet comprised of coal units. Reductions achieved since then are due to fleet diversity (coal and gas units) and investments in environmental controls.

1993-1995 – \$552 million to reduce SO₂ 90 percent

Associated spent \$552 million to close its Missouri mine and switch to cleaner, low-sulfur coal at its New Madrid and Thomas Hill power plants. This conversion reduced sulfur dioxide emissions (SO₂) nearly 90 percent to more than fulfill requirements of the 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments.

2000-2007 – \$122 million to reduce NO_x emissions

- Associated installed selective catalytic reduction (SCR) equipment at New Madrid Power Plant, at a cost of nearly \$100 million, designed to reduce nitrogen oxides emissions up to 90 percent.
- At both coal plants, AECI added a technology known as “over-fire air” on all units from 2004-2006 to further reduce NO_x emissions for a cost of \$15.5 million.
- Replacement low-NO_x burners were installed in 2006 on Thomas Hill Unit 3 to reduce NO_x emissions and lower operating costs on SCR equipment. The project cost \$7.6 million.

2006-2009 – \$423 million to reduce NO_x 90 percent

AECI constructed environmental controls at its Thomas Hill Energy Center to further reduce NO_x emissions and fulfill air quality requirements. The \$423 million project included construction of SCRs on all three units; refurbishing Unit 3 equipment that captures tiny ash particles from emissions; and higher efficiency Unit 3 air heaters, needed with the SCR, that require less coal be burned to meet member demand for electricity. The project was completed by Jan. 1, 2009, to enable AECI to achieve systemwide NO_x emissions reductions and comply with EPA requirements.

2009 to present

Associated broke ground as the first to reduce mercury emissions up to 80 percent with use of CyClean refined coal at its two coal plants, beginning in 2010. Associated invested another \$35 million to further reduce mercury emissions by improving equipment that captures fine particulates, installing activated carbon injection systems and air monitoring systems for mercury. The reductions, as well as Associated's conversion to low-sulfur coal, were part of Associated's proactive work to meet EPA's mercury rule effective in 2016.

In addition to investing in environmental controls, Associated provides an energy efficiency program to members, is a leader in Missouri wind energy and has researched lower-cost technologies to reduce emissions and keep electricity affordable for its members.

The cooperative is a member of the collaborative Missourians for Monarchs, planting 32 acres for pollinators, participates in a peregrine falcon restoration program and partners with the Missouri Department of Conservation to manage its acreage and lake at Thomas Hill Energy Center for fisheries and wildlife.

Environmental controls increase costs, not MW

Environmental control measures to improve air quality costs Associated Electric and its members about \$45 million a year, including fixed and operating costs. This does not include costs to manage regulations on land and water resources.

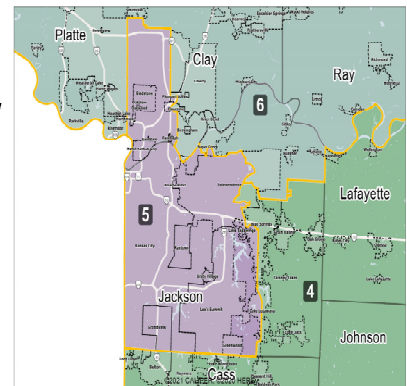
THE ONE-HUNDRED-SIXTY-THREE REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICTS OF MISSOURI



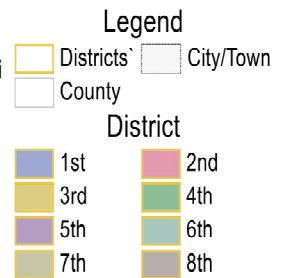
THE EIGHT CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS OF MISSOURI
